

From: Iuvina B.-outreach chair

Its been a busy two months for outreach especially since I missed last months area. I have several things to report to the area and homegroups.

1. The Nash Correctional Institution meeting

The group itself in the institution in fantastic, we have an average of 22 inmates that attend with an average of 2 newcomers. Unity is very important to the group and old-timers to help and answer questions when newcomers come into the group. They have a format, group positions filled and are eager and hungry for their recovery. Some of the obstacles I have been facing with the institution are literature being approved (the group needs ALL IPS and living clean book), having sponsors, bringing in a phone list that was previously approved. Myself and the PR chair are waiting for institution approval to do an NA Presentation for the superintendent and Programs Director, we feel this would give them better understanding of the program and would eliminate all the red tape I am facing. The inmates would also love to have workshops such as what is the NA program and working the steps, however I am still waiting on approval for that as well even though the inmates turned in that proposal a year ago before I came into this position. WE currently have myself and 2 volunteers going into this prison, as well as waiting for 2 other volunteers to finish the application. Again, I will state that I will not approach under institutions in our area until this one is squared away.

2. New NA/Recovery Groups

Please be aware of out 4th tradition which states "Each group should be autonomous except when in matters affecting others groups or NA as a whole". It has been brought to my attention (as the outreach chair) that we have several new NA groups popping up into our area. As this is good news and we welcome new groups please keep in mind of our traditions. I was made aware of a new group in Roanoke Rapids that is sending a very confusing message, has no real understanding of our fellowship and is promoting methadone/suboxone use. They are using the NA symbols, and closing their meetings to "NA Suboxone members only" which as we all know, it is not an NA approved meeting. Several people in my homegroup have gone to that meeting and it was suggested to me that a presentation should be done to educate the Clinician that runs that meeting. I will work on getting in touch with her and see when myself and PR chair can meet with her to educate her on the NA program. If you hear of a new "NA" group please let me know, or if you would like for me to come with you to one please again let me know. Its not about being the NA police its about spreading a clear message of recovering and not causing harmful confusion to the newcomer and our fellowship.

3. Services with outreach

If you are interested in doing service with outreach, I will no longer be bringing applications to meeting nor will I be meeting people at their homegroups for that sole purpose. If you are interested in

volunteering or have any questions, please come to the subcommittee meeting at area which meets the second Saturday of every month at noon. Also, if your application is approved please get with me before that institutional meeting to talk about some guidelines when going into the prisons.

I appreciate this area's support as I continue my service position and my primary purpose in this fellowship.
