It has been another busy month for Outreach, the following are points of business for the month of November.

- The first order of business is my visit to the Recovery Road Group of NA in Tarboro. On November 16, 2017 I visited the 8'oclock meeting in Tarboro and I had a great experience. I observed a variety of addicts with a variety of clean and recovery time and even one supporter. Meeting stayed on topic and I was able to witness the fellowship that is described in our NA literature. Meeting was open and it started on time. I saw no obvious issues that area needs to be aware of. If you are looking for a Thursday night meeting, I suggest everyone check out Recovery Road Group located at 1803 Sunset Avenue, EXT (yellow house across from church).
- On December 2, 2017 I attended the Kinston Service Learning Day. I had the pleasure of speaking about PI/PR and was definitely excited to be able to share some of the things our area is doing and has done when it comes to service. Over 30 people attended and it was just an incredible experience. The hunger for service knowledge and experience that I witnessed from both old timers and newcomers was too awesome to describe. We had Q & A sessions, and I was so pleased to see the all answers given were NA literature based answers. The DEICCNA Convention committee was there also taking registrations for their upcoming convention on January 26-28, as well a food plate fundraiser was going on. The only part of the service learning day that was disheartening was when someone brought up the struggle of getting people in the fellowship to volunteer to do outreach and H & I. Several areas and region was represented and a few outreach, H & I chair and volunteers shared the same message that people are refusing to volunteer to go into the prisons to keep up at 5th tradition and our primary purpose. We received news that Craven Correctional Institution will be closing its doors to NA due to the inconsistency of the volunteers. Other prisons are adapting a new policy stating that inmates CANNOT have or carry an NA meeting without outside NA representation present. Our region H & I chair spoke and said "that he gets weekly phone calls from different institutions in the state

that are begging for someone from NA to come in and sadly all he can do is pass the information down the line because nobody is volunteering to go and due to his job with the state, he is no longer allowed to go in himself". I urge everyone to think about, where would you be in your recovery if you had to depend on someone else to get the NA message and that someone else was refusing to share that lifesaving message.

Lastly.....

- I have stopped trying to communicate with Odom prison, until I get a consistent flow of volunteers to go with me to Nash Correctional Institution. My goal is to build a list of volunteers and regular visits at Nash for a bit and then move on to Odom and then hopefully finish up the year with building a relationship with Caledonia/Tiller.
- News from Nash Correctional Institution, we are lucky to have a really great and supportive point of contact in this institution who really wants our presence there. He is being patient with me and the process of gathering volunteers. As already talked about during the Kinston learning day, people in the fellowship just DO NOT want to do service, and because of this decision prison meetings and addicts that are incarcerated are suffering. I have yet to have one volunteer who has turned in an application to come with me to the Thursday night meeting in the prison at Nash. However I am meeting with 4 members of the fellowship tonight and they have shown interest in filling out the applications tonight so it can be mailed in. We need more than just 4 volunteers though, so please get in touch with me if you are interested in helping out. Also the question I have been getting asked when spreading this announcement is "are convicted felons allowed to apply? I have reached out to Mr. Herring which is my point of contact for Nash Correctional and this is his answer and I quote "Regarding Felons volunteering....it is not an uncommon practice. The volunteer will have to be completely separated from any correctional supervision for one (1) year. No sex offender or those convicted of sexual related offenses will be allowed to volunteer for the Division of Prisons. Of course there is no right to volunteer, so the Facility administrator/ designee has the final say so regarding volunteer approval".

That is all the information I have for the Tar-Roanoke Area at this time, Thank you for allowing me to serve.
