Fraud Detection Products. This will provide you with access to your funds during the time it takes us to complete our investigation. You may have no liability for unauthorized Check Card purchases, subject to the terms and conditions in the current BB&T Electronic Fund Transfer Agreement and Disclosures. If you have arranged for direct deposit(s) to your account, please call BB&T Phone24 at 1-800-BANK BBT to verify that a deposit has been made.

If your periodic statement shows transfers that you did not make, tell us at once.
