Hello Family,

Thank you for electing me to serve as our 2016 Treasurer

In the attached report you will see a detail description consisting of Feb 2016 Bank statement, and Monthly reports; detailing income and expenses. The Monthly Table is a rolling table capturing our 12 month donations and expenses with averages to verify our prudent reserve.

For Jan 2016, Area home groups have donated \$79. Our two expenses were \$50.00 rent to Compassion Worship Center in Roanoke Rapids, and USPS for 6 Month rent on PO Box for \$43.00, for a total of \$93.00. We have one outstanding checks currently not cashed for Rent of \$50.00. Our current ending balance is \$736.10, which is under our area prudent reserve is \$750.00. Therefore No donation was sent to Region. Our three month average expense is \$294, and our yearly average expense of \$197; which is significantly less than our three month \$750.00 prudent reserve.
