- ⊙ Attended RSC meeting April 25 in Greensboro.
- ⊙ Received receipts for ASC donations.
- ⊙ 6 of 9 areas must be present, quorum met
- ⊙ Traditions project, traditions 2-6 are out for fellowship review.
- ⊙ RD report from Florida Symposium included indepth discussion of Medically Assisted Therapy (formerly drug replacement therapy) and the fellowships need to come up with a ruling as to how that effects clean time as it relates to the ability to hold service commitments. The doctors present were upset that the general consensus of NA members present was those addicts are not clean. The debate was focused on the difference of mind altering drugs that change the mind from it's natural state as aposed to those drugs whose intent is to return the mind to a normal state as prescribed by psychiatrists.
- ⊙ New study, the average cleantime in NA is more than sobriety time of AA or any other 12 step fellowship.
- ⊙ New enhanced step working guide has simplified doing stepwork electronically
- ⊙ Florida Symposium cost roughly \$20,000 and is fully paid by Florida region. There is no cost to the other 5 regions. It may be given to zonal forum and regions will then split cost.
- ⊙ Southern Piedmont Area and Crossroads area just did poster drive, Greensboro Area does one every 3 months.
- ⊙ New business motion for PI funding up to \$359 outside of budget for banner and literature for upcoming event.
- * ⊙ Need to bring back dates for CAR workshops that should start in January, preferably multi area events to be both time and resource prudent.
- ⊙ Zonal forum is working on several projects to clean up teleconference meetings with RD/ADs in hopes of allowing other members in once the bugs are out.
- ⊙ DEI2CNA convention may be as soon as October or as late as January or February.

January motions 2 and 3 carried, motion 4 failed.

MOTION 1: No Action Required. WITHDRAWN – not needed as Vice Chair resigned.

MOTION 2: To except clean up to policy. For example, punctuation, spelling, repetition and grammar.

MOTION 3: To put into policy that punctuation, grammar and non-substantial changes can be made by the policy chair without having to go back to the home groups.

MOTION 4: This is a straw poll with a home group tally – Would your home group support the Region joining the USSCNA? If the Region does join, it would be in support only because Regions have NO vote. Voting at the USSCNA is by registered member home groups only.

**Policy motions generally need rewording prior to going into policy. If the rewording is not done prior to vote then policy committee needs vote of confidence to make the grammatical changes and rephrasing to fit policy*
