Hello Family,

Thank you for electing me to serve as our 2016 Treasurer

In the attached report you will see a detail description consisting of April 2016 Bank statement, and Monthly reports; detailing income and expenses. The Monthly Table is a rolling table capturing our 12 month donations and expenses with averages to verify our prudent reserve.

For April 2016, Area home groups have donated \$181. Our two expenses were \$50.00 rent to United Community Ministries, leaving us a balance of \$880. Therefore I wrote a check to NC Region for \$130.00, for a total of \$180.00, giving us a balance of \$750. To meet our prudent reserve. We have no outstanding checks currently. We had a Monthly bank service charge of \$2.00. Now our current ending balance is \$748.00, which is under our area prudent reserve is \$750.00.

Our three month average expense is \$374, which is significantly less than our three month \$750.00 prudent reserve (3 Months expenses). For the last 12 Months, our monthly average Home Group contributions were \$176/Month and our Monthly average expense for the year is \$205/Month, equating to a \$29 deficit/month. We had seven months in the last 12 months were our expenses were greater then our home group contributions.

Once again I ask; should we re-evaluate our prudent reserve? (No recent Out Reach or H&I expenses)

Tar-Roanoke Area, Regional Committee Member report

May 14, 2016



Attended RSC meeting 4/16/16 in Greensboro accompanied by our alternate RCM. Attended PR meeting prior to RSC where new meeting list integration and possibility of a regional or statewide phonenumber to save area funds as well as having a more uniform service. The question created through CAT discussions that is being discussed at lengths through area PR committees is "Who is missing from our meetings" and what can we do to be a part of the solution.

- Opening regional balance \$5227.21, closing balance before NAWS donation \$7065. (\$2065 NAWS donation). Secretary performed treasure audit.
- 6 of 9 areas present, quorum met.
- Elections held all positions filled which is a first and somewhat of a challenge.
- We received the Basic Test from the East Coast Convention.
- Insurance: Be advised all events and locations that hold NA events do not require insurance and some events may require a special rider that could cost from \$100-\$300 per event that currently will be covered by the region, that could change. Any event with attendance of 500 or more will definitely require rider. We are asking for 30 days to process the event request that will allow time for dialogue between entities. There will be a form online that can be filled out and submitted. Always include flyer for event if available and as much detail as possible. Some activities are more likely to trigger the need for a rider. We emphasize honesty in submitted request, there are laws governing lying to your insurance company.
- PR is planning to attend the Licensed Practitioner Conference in Charlotte the cost will be \$300.
- AD reports the tentative plan for the Southeast Zonal Forum meeting in NC in 2016 possible at Fayetteville convention due to proximity of airport. Other regions will better fund forum due to larger contributions from areas, service offices, and conventions creating greater income. Our region needs to look at what extent we can/ will support forum. CAR motions are unchangeable on WSC floor but we need to vote on what level of vote of confidence we want our RD to have when things are presented or changed on the conference floor.
- Several live Facebook pages will keep WSC information current during conference.
