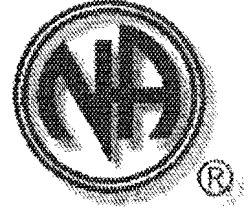

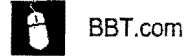

This removes Ter Rourke area from having to get our own phone line and it is funded by Region. It will cost 700⁰⁰/yr, 350⁰⁰ for Startup: 350 for next 6 months. Two numbers ~~has~~ have been given 336 area code and a 800 area code to same line. It starts w/ typing in 4 numbers for the 1st four letters in your county and then it will cycle through our Areas phone bank. If no one answers it goes to next # it will start at phone # next in line ~~and~~ on next phone call. Then it goes to voice mail. it is a hotline

Reg/Motion #2: PR request a budget of an additional \$700:00 for the implementation of a Regional Phone line, 350 for Startup and 350 for the remaining 6 months.

Budget for the RD/AD team for 2018-2020

Dear RSC, Areas, and Home groups,

I wanted to update you guys on the budget for travel for the RD/AD team since we, along with the rest of the Southeast Zonal Form (SEZF), have doubled the amount of times we meet in a cycle.

Our current budget is \$4400 and is shown on the attached sheet along with the new proposed budget of \$11,100. This is an increase by a factor of about 2.5. At first glance this seems like a big increase, and it is, but it only adds 3 meetings in an entire cycle. The following is a quick explanation of the increases.

1. The new budget includes travel for both the RD and AD to the WSC. Currently, NAWS funds the travel for the RD and The North Carolina Region funds the travel for the AD. In the spirit of self support, funding has been added for both. If the funds were not available, we could still ask NAWS to fund our RD.
2. Travel amounts for each place have been updated based on current airplane prices and \$50 was used for drivable distances.
3. A hotel rate of \$100 per night and \$50 for food was used. Some places hotels are cheaper and some more expensive, this was an average.

No increase is being asked for at this time. The increase is being requested for next cycle. We want to make sure that we have enough time to discuss it. We realize that this may seem unpractical and if we are below prudent reserve obviously some of this travel would not be funded. All input is welcome.

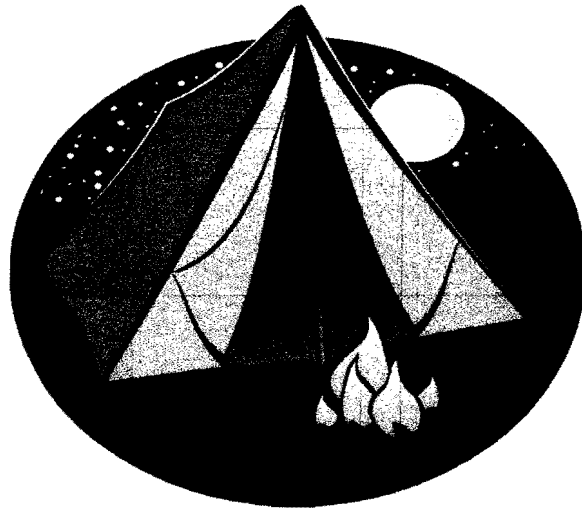
