Outreach report for May 2018

To the Tar Roanoke Area of NA

From Iuvina B. Outreach chair

On April 19th, 2018 myself and another NA outreach volunteer met with Nash Correctional Institution's Programs Director, Assistant Programs Director and the volunteer coordinator. We met for about 45 minutes, due to concerns I had about the way the institution dictated how the group was ran and what they wouldn't allow as far as NA literature, access to sponsors and other concerns I have stated in previous reports. The format of that meeting was a question and answer format, which allowed the staff to understand more about our fellowship and why the items I was requesting approval for were necessary. Some of the issues addressed were the importance of sponsorship (what is a sponsor and why the inmates need access to them) as The staff was under the impression that volunteers were there to work the steps with the inmates. NA literature approval (The living clean Book and ALL IPS), NA and AA are two separate fellowships (in past reports I have mentioned the confusion that goes on in the group do to the fact they combine both fellowships), The structure of NA and what does it mean to be a registered NA group. The staff took notes and freely asked questions which I answered with the help of NA IPS and the volunteer. I believe the meeting went well and the staff learned a lot. They seemed shocked about everything that was talked about due to the fact that no other NA volunteer including my predecessor ever took the time to educate the staff and to make sure the group had all necessary NA approved items (such as literature). I was approved to bring in the living clean books and all IPS for the group which I will order this week. The staff also explained to me the security concerns about having a phone list for the inmates, this allowed me to take a look from their perspective which I appreciated. I believe this meeting strengthened the relationship between our area and the Nash Correctional Institution.

I have made a new request of allowing me to bring in H & I key tags for the group to celebrate the clean time, as well to have something for the newcomer to work towards. I have explained the purpose of the key tags to the assistant programs director and I am waiting for approval. Myself and the volunteer coordinator have put together an approval process for speaker volunteers. The group has a speaker meeting in their format which is the fourth Thursday of the month and Mays' speaker has already been approved. Attendance has been low this past month with only 18 attending and 1 new comer. Due to an emergency I have lost one volunteer, so as of today I only have myself and one other that goes into this meeting. I do have one application to turn in on Thursday however I would like to have at least one more volunteer just in case. The institution has been briefed on NA volunteers coming in pairs and never alone. They will turn

away any NA volunteers that chooses to go in by themselves. As stated in the Guide of Local Service and other NA service literature, we do not go into hospitals and institutions by ourselves.

My goal for the month of June is to start the open line of communications with Odom Prison and start the process of getting approved to go into their meeting. Odom to my knowledge meets on weds at 6:30pm, and is located in Jackson, NC. I will need volunteers for that meeting. Please Keep in mind that I cannot start this new goal without having at least two volunteer applications to turn in. Once I have the application packet and knowledge of the process for Odom, I will bring applications to the area with me, so people can fill it out and ask questions during the time the subcommittees meet (noon).

One last thing on my agenda is to go into the new Roanoke Rapids meeting and speak with the clinician that runs the new group. PR has already put together a presentation to educate the staff, so this week I will be going into that office and request an appointment to meet. Our goal is to make sure that everyone involved understands and knows the NA Fellowship and the NA clarity statement as well as to let them know that NA welcomes all addicts according to our third tradition.

I appreciate this area for the support, for my service predecessors for answering all my questions and for the homegroups for allowing me to service in this position.
