They have been asking for NA to show up for more than a year. AA and a few churches sponsor them but no NA. I was asked to plead for them wherever I could that they need our support and are working a NA program of recovery to the best of their ability and need NA sponsors. Prior to my 1st meeting staff asked me how many would I be able to sponsor and if I had any help. In the 20 plus years I have been clean it was one of the few times I felt ashamed to be in Narcotics Anonymous.

I will show up, and I will serve to the best of my ability, but without help addicts will suffer and that is not on me. Even a NA purist as myself knows of the AA responsibility statement. As addicts are we responsible or not???

Report highlights:

H&I still open Chair is filling in. 1st H&I learning day is 8/23 in Lillington, would like to hold the next one in our area. Has hopes that we will be represented on 23d with our ASC's conscience. This would be an RSC sponsored event.

Extensive research and discussion on NAWS/RSC/ASC tax structure. NAWS is clearly 501c3 the remainder of our service structure entities with \$50,000 or less gross receipts would fall under 501c4 which would only require a one page, 5-6 question, reporting annually. Be advised that all EIN obtained to open are account are deleted from system if no tax document is filed for 3 consecutive years.

At world conference the 1st motion on floor was to continue conscience based decision making that has been implemented and used to some degree during last few conferences. This allowed some Ads to change their votes on the floor rather than carry the conscience sent by their region. It is assumed they had vote of confidence to do so and acted in their best interest. The votes was so overwhelming from our region the AD presented them just as tallied and voted accordingly. Motions 4-6 would have passed by 51% required due to phrase 'agree in principle', without that terminology they would have failed by the required 2/3 majority.

Most insurance companies either would not meet our criteria and one that Florida region uses simply refused to give us a bid. The active bid we have is approx. \$1900 per year including assault and will cover all groups, all events, and all conventions in our region. It was \$1615 without the assault rider. Based on who we serve the consensus is assault rider is a good idea.

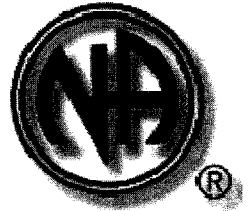

When two or more addicts come together to help each other stay clean, they may form a Narcotics Anonymous group. Here are six points based on our traditions which describe an NA group:

- 1. All members of a group are drug addicts, and all drug addicts are eligible for membership.
- 2. As a group, they are self-supporting.
- 3. As a group, their single goal is to help drug addicts recover through application of the Twelve Steps of Narcotics Anonymous.
- 4. As a group, they have no affiliation outside Narcotics Anonymous.
- 5. As a group, they express no opinion on outside issues.
- 6. As a group, their public relations policy is based on at-

General information that applies to NA meetings

We are not concerned with types or amounts of drugs used; we focus on the ways addiction and recovery affect our lives. NA meetings are not classes or group therapy sessions. We do not teach lessons or provide counseling. We simply share our personal experiences with addiction and recovery. Meetings are often held in churches, treatment centers, or other facilities, because these places tend to be affordable, available, or convenient. NA is not a part of or connected to any other group, organization, or institution. To respect the anonymity of all of our members, we ask that people who attend our meetings not talk about who our members are or what they share in meetings. NA has no membership fees or dues, but it does spend money to hold meetings and provide other services to further our primary purpose. Our members make voluntary contributions at meetings to support the group and other efforts to carry our message. Nonmembers are asked not to contribute so NA can remain fully self-supporting.

Our new friends in the Fellowship will help us. Our common effort is recovery. Clean, we face the world together. We no longer have to feel backed into a corner, at the mercy of events and circumstances. It makes a difference to have friends who care if we hurt.
